The Circle [2014] - 70 min, 6 actors. Dramaturgy by Jonathan Garfinkel. Directed by Ann-Marie Kerr, New Words Festival.

It's a garage party. Amanda is a genius. Ily is a drug dealer. Kit is a runaway. Mutt is a mess. Will has ADHD. Daniel is the son of a priest. Something bad is going to happen.

Still Still Still [2013] - 70 min, 6 actors. Dramaturgy by Iris Turcott.

Red. Heartbeat. Everyone is always there. Everything happens at once and in one moment. Inspired by the book The Mind of A Mnemonist by Alexander Luria, the case study of a man with five-fold synesthesia, Still Still Still is an experiential manifestation of the world through the senses of the man who cannot forget.

Spitzfrankengurkle [2013] - TYA, 50 min, 2 actors. Dramaturgy by Dean Patrick Fleming. Co-written with Britney Tangedal.

Spitzfrankengurkle is the smallest island in the Calibri sea. It's so small that the only house on the island is Grandma's! And guess what! Every Spitzfrankengurklin on the island lives in her house! Would you like to hear the story of how the island of Spitzfrankengurkle came to be so small? Spitzfrankengurkle is a children's play about the environment and the economy.

Timothy And The Lizard [2013] - Solo Performance, 20 min. Dramaturgy and direction by Adam Lazarus and Jodi Essery.

Growing up is hard. Timothy is ten years old, dealing with puberty, fitting in, and the lizard living inside his rectum. Yonnie may be a parasite who's spent ten years in Reno living inside a Mexican prostitute named Alfonso Gueres, but he's also Timothy's only friend. What's a boy to do?

The Hole [2012] – 60 min, 2 actors. Dramaturgy by Brian Drader.

Alice and Georg live in a crumbling cellar. Outside is ash and darkness. For Georg this is the end. For Alice it's another beginning. A grave, a shrine, a dead tree, an alcohol still, a butterfly, love, and the end of the world.

The Mysterious Memory of Ella Chase [2012] - Adaptation, 50 min, 10-43 actors. Dramaturgy by Nick Carpenter.

A goat stands on a cow's back. Letters scatter across highway 101. Radio reporter Laura Starechesky is pulled farther from security and closer to insanity as she tries to answer the question: who is Ella Chase? And it all happens live on the radio!
